PHOTOSTOP Gallery seeks photographs of trains, the railroad, and the railroad experience for its first juried exhibition. Train travel has long had a romantic association. Today there's both a renewed interest in our railroad system and recognition of the very real challenges it faces.

The Gallery is located in White River Junction, VT, just steps from the Amtrak rail system. The town was the first and largest railroad center in Vermont and New England north of Boston. Photographers must live in the New England states of NH, VT, MA, RI, ME, and CT to enter but the photographs can be of any location. Juror Tony Decaneas will choose approximately 30 photographs, depending on sizes, for exhibition during the show.

On September 11 White River Junction will hold its 18<sup>th</sup> Annual Glory Days of the Railroad Festival, an event chosen as one of the Top Ten events by the VT Chamber of Commerce in 2007.

**Entry fee:** \$25 for up to 3 entries, additional entries \$5 each, maximum of 5 submissions

**Juror:** Tony Decaneas is the former owner of the Panopticon Gallery in Boston, MA. After forty years in the photography gallery business, Tony is now the owner of Decaneas Archive, a Dealer/Agency representing the photographic collections of Harold Feinstein, Vittorio Sella, Bradford Washburn and Ernest C. Withers.

**Jurying will be done by digital files provided by the photographer.**

If **mailing** a CD (no DVD's) please include the following:

1. Completed entry form with all contact information
2. Payment of your entry fee (by check only) made out to PHOTOSTOP Gallery for \$25 for 3 entries, additional images (up to 5 total) \$5 each additional photo fee
3. A disk with your JPEG (highest quality compression) images labeled and sized as specified below
4. A SASE (self-addressed stamped envelope) of the proper size for the return of your disk and application materials if you'd like them returned to you

Images will not be considered for jurying until the entry fee has been submitted on the website.
3. If you're submitting over 8 MB of image data, you will need to send the JPEG images in several batches. Please label photos carefully according to the directions below.
